

HIND BOOTS - FEI COMPLIANT

According to the Jumping Rules approved by the FEI General Assembly, only hind boots as described in JRS Art. 257.2.3 and Art. 257.2.4 may be used at international Jumping Events. Refer to the below guide to understand which ones are allowed.

1: BOOTS WITH ONE PROTECTIVE ELEMENT ON THE INSIDE

1.1: Strap-type fasteners



1.2: Stud-type fasteners



2: DOUBLE SHELL PROTECTION
